What is Yokohama 2020?

The first major international sport science conference was held in 1964, when the Tokyo 1964 Olympic Games were held in Japan. Since then it has been held every four years in the country where the Olympic and Paralympic Games are held. On this occasion of the Olympic and Paralympic Games being held once again in Tokyo in 2020, this conference will be held with the cooperation of the International Council of Sport Science and Physical Education (ICSSPE), with an aim of carrying on the history of these international conferences in Japan and contributing significantly to advances in this area and to development of human society.

The ICSSPE is an international organisation established for the purpose of promoting scientific research into physical activity, recreation and sport. It was formed in Paris in 1958 as the International Council of Sport and Physical Education (ICSPE), and changed its name as to ICSSPE in 1982. Membership of the ICSSPE currently consists of approximately 230 international and domestic organisations involved in sport, physical education and sport science, and its activities are conducted in close cooperation with organisations such as the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO), the International Olympic Committee (IOC), the World Health Organization (WHO), and the International Federation of Sports Medicine (FIMS). ICSSPE contributes to the development of human society through advocating investigation and research, education and healthy sport activities, creating interdisciplinary cooperative relationships via the world's largest network in this field interconnecting several million people.

Even in this day and age when international conferences are no longer a rarity, it is an extremely unique and valuable opportunity to have those multi-disciplinary and multi-industry experts in physical education, physical activity and sport gather in one place to collaborate in exploring clues for resolving complex social issues and developing a vision for our future.
